A **Sure Visit** with intent to bring awareness of vulnerable children's plight to equal educational opportunities, [TGAEV](#) is our big program where the founder in celebration of his 14 years since the founding of the organization has decided to travel to 6 African countries, 7 including Zimbabwe our home country and in that he will be visiting a total of 14 organizations with whom he will create a consortium with. The journey is aimed at all organizations that are focused on children's education and their wellbeing.

CAREER GUIDANCE

Free Education has become our mantra, exposure to the outside world, experiential learning, career guidance. Now our learners are only exposed to the rural set-up and even with mainstream education there is a gap when it comes to career guidance. With the on-going tours for the Great African Exposure Visit we are running career guidance sessions at the farm for children that have dreams but have no idea what comes with their dreams. In collaboration with [Flight Wings Aviation](#) and [Women in Aviation International Zimbabwe](#) we brought the airport at home. You see we ask what our learners wish to be in the future and they say a pilot, an engineer, a doctor and so forth, but the power is in showing what their career of choice has to really offer. It is their excitement that made our day, the first time ever in Selous to have an event of this kind. Your future is not determined by where you come from, Rural does not mean they have to only exist in this area and end here. With such programs we are securing their future with free trainings etc. But mainstream education remains essential, that is why we are in support of the establishment of the trust fund through TGAEV- THE GREAT AFRICAN EXPOSURE VISIT.

“Girls not brides” is not just a statement-we make it a reality that girls stay in school and enjoy their childhood.

Women in aviation, that is a catchy line- seeing women explaining what aviation is all about to the girls gave us all the hope there is for the rural girls. We met aircraft engineers, we mean **WOMEN AIRCRAFT ENGINEERS**, yes our girls were not just excited but they were inspired to change the course of their lives. With a scarcity of opportunities in rural areas, the only thing that remains for the girls is getting married and looking for field work to fend for their homes. Now we sure then have children with children and this has to end. Through such programs we will identify all their talents and career of choice and nature those step by step.

The same goes out for the boys who are also forced into child labor because of the circumstances in the rural community. They are not man; they are boys who deserve to be in school and as well enjoy being young. #freeducation #boysnotworkers #girlsnotbrides #tgaev

The girls had their first ever experience with a flight simulator during the career guidance session with most of them hitting 79% on their first trial, now isn't that something to celebrate?
